

# CREEPING RED FESCUE

*Festuca arundinacea*

This fine leaf turf grass is used a great deal in combinations with Kentucky Bluegrass and other fine leaf grasses for lawns.

We recommend Creeping Red Fescue for planting on lawns in shade areas of the Piedmont sections and other Northern sections of the Southern United States.

The beautiful green color of the fine leaf makes it a most desirable lawn grass.

The grass is fairly disease free and will stand heavy use as a lawn when properly cared for. Plant seed anytime from early fall until mid spring.

Plant 8 pounds per 1,000 square feet for lawns.
